## Danforth Avenue Woodbine Avenue to Dawes Road Road Resurfacing & Sidewalk Replacement

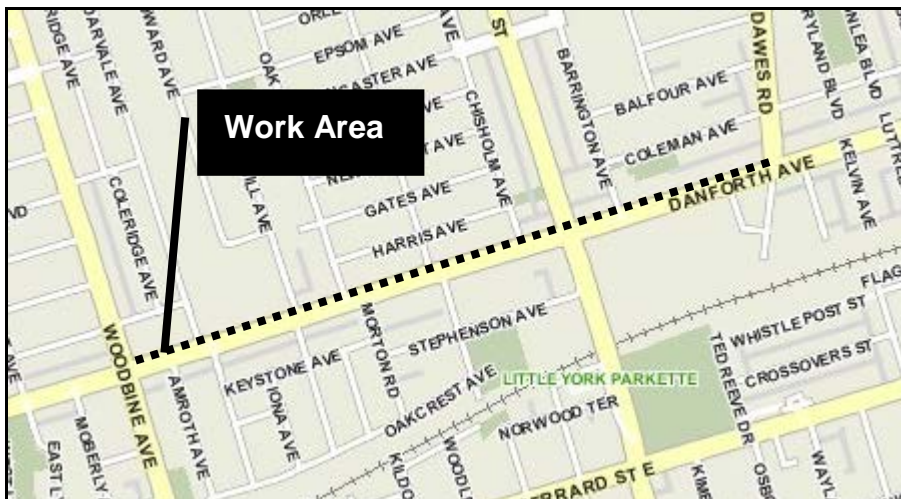
**Expected Project Start Date: June 2014**  
**Expected Completion Date: Mid September 2014**

As part of the upcoming Danforth Construction Project, the City of Toronto will be carrying out road resurfacing work, restoration of utility cuts, sidewalk replacement and construction of accessibility ramps. **Work will be carried out on Danforth Avenue from Woodbine Avenue to Dawes Road.**

Further notice will be given to you prior to construction. It will provide a more accurate start date, staging details and other information regarding the work. ## Project Details

The construction work will require temporary lane closures and proper staging of the work to allow smooth traffic flow. It may also mean that there could be limited access to private property. The City's contractor will notify property owners of these types of disruptions beforehand. Alternative parking arrangements will be made if access to driveways is limited. Access for all services (i.e. garbage collection, emergency vehicles or any other usual services) will be maintained. Every effort will be made to complete all works under this project with minimum inconvenience to the public.

Many people have planted landscaping, fences, irrigation systems or other physical features in front of their property which are within the City property limits. These may be in the way of the construction. In such cases, property owners are advised to remove these items prior to the beginning of construction in order to avoid unnecessary damage. The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items installed on the City's property.

## Next Steps

1. Select the contractor
2. Issue the Construction Notice
3. Prepare the site
4. Carry out a pre-construction survey
5. Commence construction
